<u>Cluster Aims and Objectives</u>

PURPOSE:

To work together, both within schools and with our partner organisations, to share ideas, resources and expertise across our settings, inspired by the Curriculum for Wales. To support and facilitate the highest outcomes in attainment and aspirations for our pupils, parents, families, staff and our wider communities. To enrich and improve the Welsh nature of our locality.

AIMS:

1. To provide rich, high quality, engaging, inspiring learning experiences for all.

2. To work together with trust and respect to raise standards and improve teaching & learning across our community of schools.

3. To bring coherence across phases whilst still allowing each school's curriculum to reflect their distinct identity.

4. To generate opportunities for improved outcomes across our community of schools.

5. To work together towards the National Mission for Welsh in Wales.

6. To share and pool resources to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the schools in our community.

7. To provide community support and development for all stakeholders, ensuring that they feel that they belong to a of schools which they can easily approach for support and information without any barriers.

8. To build relationships with all staff across the cluster of schools, provide support for individual Heads and sustain effective leadership across the community of schools.

9. To celebrate diversity and encourage inclusion.

MISSION: To work to secure outstanding educational achievement which will enhance the life chances of all pupils.

Our mission statement underpins all cluster activities.

The implementation of the above aims relies upon the development of a common educational philosophy, which recognises that no one partner is any more or less important than the other.

The Plan sets out how we will work together to realise the above aims. It summarises aims and priorities agreed by partner schools for the period September 2022 - July 2025, and indicates the work to be addressed in 2022-23.

The progress made and next steps will be reviewed and agreed annually by partner schools. We will seek the views of parents, carers and pupils on the Plan and approach taken, and work in partnership with colleagues in the local education authority.

The Plan addresses the action that will be taken against the core requirements set out in guidance provided by the Welsh Assembly Government:

- 3. Achieving continuity in teaching and learning methods.

4. Achieving consistency in assessment and monitoring and tracking pupils' progress against prior attainment

5. Evaluation of the impact of the Plan and improvement activities on standards.

In addition, the Plan sets out how we shall work together to ensure that there are effective arrangements for transition in the following areas:

- 6. Pastoral links to meet pupils' personal, social and learning needs;
- 7. Involving parents/guardians in the transition process
- 8. Sharing information about pupils' achievements and attainment;

In each case, the Plan identifies current and ongoing work. Where areas for improvement are identified, we shall agree priorities and work together to address these over the period of the Plan.
